Sr. Eva Gaughan was Clerical Employee in the hospital at the full-time service of doctors and other Staff, in the 1960's and 1970's. The priests from St. Muredach's College faithfully celebrated Eucharist every morning in what was known as the Little Convent, as a service to the Sisters who lived there. Eucharist was also celebrated in the Little Convent every Saturday night, with Constance McGinley providing the music.
