## Quiz Answers

1) The human body is $\mathbf{6 6 \%}$ or two-thirds water.
2) For one orange, $\mathbf{5 2}$ litres of water are needed.
3) Approx. 79 million $(79,493,647)$ litres spill each day from the Trevi fountain
4) For the average person's daily diet, between 2000 and $\mathbf{5 0 0 0}$ litres of water are used (see examples below of water usage)
5) Since the year 1900, over $\mathbf{1 1}$ million people have died as a result of droughts, and 2 billion people have been affected
6) Eritrea is the most difficult place in the world to access clean water

## Examples of water usage in food production

tea: 107 litres $=1$ litre brewed tea
coffee : 1,051 litres $=1$ litre brewed coffee
pasta: 1,849 litres = 1 kg pasta
chicken: 4,325 litres $=1 \mathrm{~kg}$ chicken
apples: 822 litres $=1 \mathrm{~kg}$ apples
butter : 5,553 litres = 1 kg butter
