- 1) The human body is **66%** or two-thirds water.
- 2) For one orange, **52** litres of water are needed.
- 3) Approx. **79** million (79,493,647) litres spill each day from the Trevi fountain
- 4) For the average person's daily diet, between **2000** and **5000** litres of water are used (see examples below of water usage)
- 5) Since the year 1900, over **11** million people have died as a result of droughts, and 2 billion people have been affected
- 6) **Eritrea** is the most difficult place in the world to access clean water

Examples of water usage in food production

tea: 107 litres = 1 litre brewed tea coffee: 1,051 litres = 1 litre brewed coffee

pasta: 1,849 litres = 1 kg pasta chicken: 4,325 litres = 1 kg chicken apples: 822 litres = 1 kg apples butter: 5,553 litres = 1 kg butter
