Later, teaching Sisters were sent to Mutomo and to Ngarariga, where a convent and a clinic were also established. Others went to a convent and school at Karen in Nairobi, teaching and working in the Development Office of the Archdiocese. Kenyan girls joined Mercy in the central novitiate founded by the Dublin Diocesan Sisters.

After the Second Vatican Council, Sisters from other Irish dioceses began to collaborate in the apostolate, as did lay volunteers. Funding for all these projects was difficult. Regular gifts of money and materials came from the Elphin diocese: from apostolic workers, students, parents, parishioners and from the convents in California.
