The first Postulant, Alice Meagher, entered in Swinford in 1857. She was called Sr. Augustine and was among the first Sisters to go on a mission overseas. She arrived in Omaha, Nebraska in 1864. There, she held the office of Mother Assistant. She died of consumption in 1867, and is buried in Holy Sepulchre Cemetery, Omaha. Sr. Joseph Graham left Swinford to replace her. She remained at Omaha until 1871 and then went to Burlingame, California working there until her death in 1911.
