Nairobi

Sisters live in various areas of Nairobi and have different ministries.

Central

<u>Ngarariga</u> is the focus of formation. Postulants, their Formator and the Sister responsible for Vocation Promotion reside there.

Eastlands Area

Makadara and its neighbour McAuley House are situated in the Eastlands area. It is home for Sisters who are studying and teaching and a Sister who works in <u>Mukuru Promotion Centre</u>. Also included in the compound is the <u>Makadara Clinic</u> and Huruma (meaning Mercy) Secondary School.

Kasarani Sub-County

<u>Malagasy Crescent</u> situated in the Kahawa, Kasarani Sub-County is one of the newer communities. It is home to two Sisters who are involved in counselling.

South B Area

<u>Baraka Court</u> which is a community for eight Sisters who work in the <u>Mukuru Promotion Centre</u>, the <u>Mater Hospital</u> and provides accommodation for Sister students.

The <u>Mater Convent</u> accommodates 4 Sisters who are or were involved in the medical field.

<u>Mazinga Road</u> is a newer property purchased by the Sisters of Mercy in Kenya. It provides accommodation for volunteers on a short term basis and is home to two Sisters.

Westlands

<u>Villa Maria</u> is the Provincial House and serves as a hospitality house where many visitors stay. It is also home to three Sisters.
