2020-2025	Built small schools, provided scholarships, uniforms, and clinics, in Sudan (Nuba Mountains), Zambia, Nigeria, Cambodia, Kenya.	As of the 2020 – many children, especially girls are availing of education. Built 11 schools to date.
“Green wall / Laudato Tree” (around 2020)	Environmental-focus campaign across parts of Africa, inspired by environmental concerns and the global pandemic context.	Raised \$35,000 for the “green wall” initiative. 1
COVID-era response / “Tea pickers” campaign (2021)	Provided aid for vulnerable young girls working in tea gardens (India). (Many at risk of exploitation or trafficking), we provided shelter, food, hygiene supplies, COVID awareness.	Funds and support delivered through the Arise Foundation UK
“Women at the Well” water-access campaign (2022–2023)	Fundraising to build water wells in rural Nigeria, to free up time for girls/women otherwise walking long distances for water.	6 wells built in Nigeria because of this campaign.
2023–2024 global fundraising campaign	Joint fundraising by participating Mercy high schools for global education-related projects (education access in Kenya, Nigeria, Afghanistan, South Sudan)	Raised over 50K in the 2023–24 school year.
